Rate Increase

Our water is supplied under contract with Kansas City Water Service Department. Effective May 1, 2011 they increased the wholesale rates charged to PWSD #4 by \$0.11 per 1,000 gallons. This increase will appear on June bills for your May usage. The \$12 minimum for 1,000 gallons remains the same. The cost for each addition 1,000 gallons used will go from \$5.65 to \$5.76

2010 Water Quality Report Platte County PWSD No. 4

The water quality report is a requirement of the EPA’s Safe Water Drinking Act. This report lists those regulated substances found in measurable quantities in PWSD No. 4’s drinking water. The district’s drinking water meets or exceeds all standards of quality set by the Federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR.)

Kansas City Water Service Department processes water from the Missouri River and treats the water with chloramines in a disinfection process. PWSD #4 also has a contract with Platte City, MO which purchases water from Kansas City WSD. Two emergency connections are established with Platte County CWSD No. 1, which also purchases its water from Kansas City. The Red Rock Well Field located three miles east of Platte City is a 160,000 gallon a day production facility with water that is treated with chloramines for disinfection purposes. This disinfection process kills disease causing organisms and insures the microbiological safety of our water for all of our patrons.
